Who should apply: Members of the Agent/ Broker/ Consultant (A/B/C) channel transacting in the state of Illinois who are interested in upholding the integrity of deregulated retail energy brokering industry should apply.

Why apply: This organization will provide a unified representation of A/B/C channel interests in matters concerning customers, suppliers, the Illinois Commerce Commission, and the transmission grid operator. In addition, the organization will serve as a forum for education and discussion on industry events. Other benefits include: participating as one consolidated voice for the A/B/C community, promotion of A/B/C and supplier accountability, promotion and establishment of industry standards, industry updates, (electric rate design changes from the Illinois Commerce Commission, supplier issues, etc.), educational seminars and materials, access to forms, credibility among suppliers, and credibility among customers).

Description of application process

3. New Membership committee representative will gather additional information and contact the new applicant's industry and REP references.
4. Applicant may be asked to meet with the Board of Directors in a face-to-face interview and Q & A.
5. New Membership committee representative will present applicant to the Board of Directors for approval.
6. If application is accepted, 2009 membership dues of \$2,500 are payable to the "Illinois Electricity Professionals Association." Checks can be sent to:
